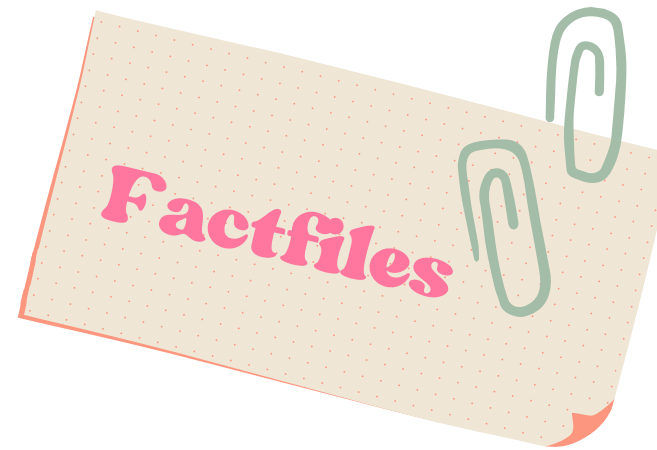
Andalucía

- Culture:

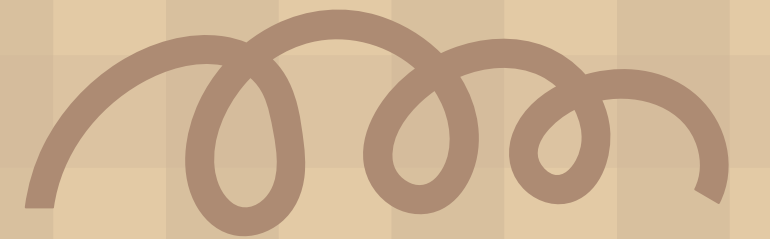
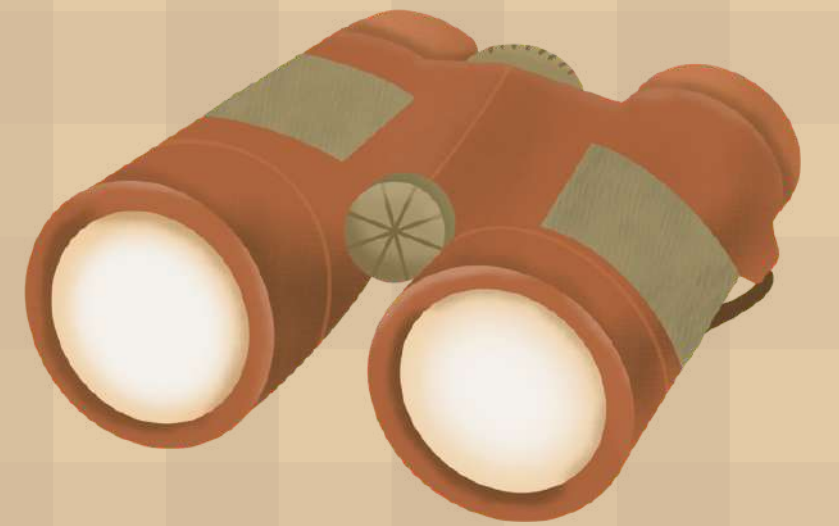
Flamenco: music and dances, such as sevillanas

Festivals: city fairs, carnival, Holy Week .

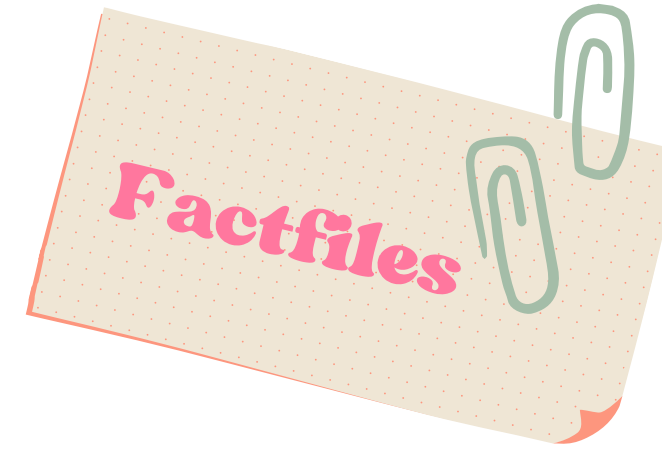
Andalusian food: gazpacho, salmorejo, fried fish, migas, tortilla de patatas, Iberian ham and, of course, olive oil.

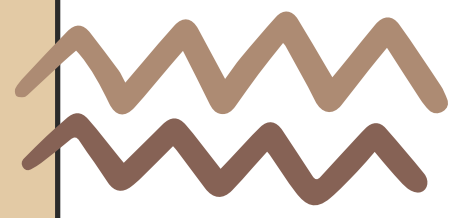
Sierra Nevada, the sunniest ski resort in Europe, 40 km from the city.

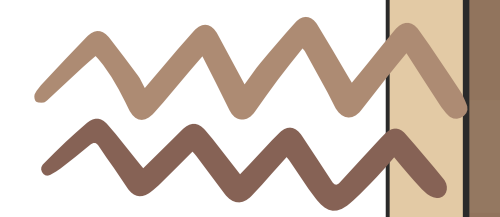
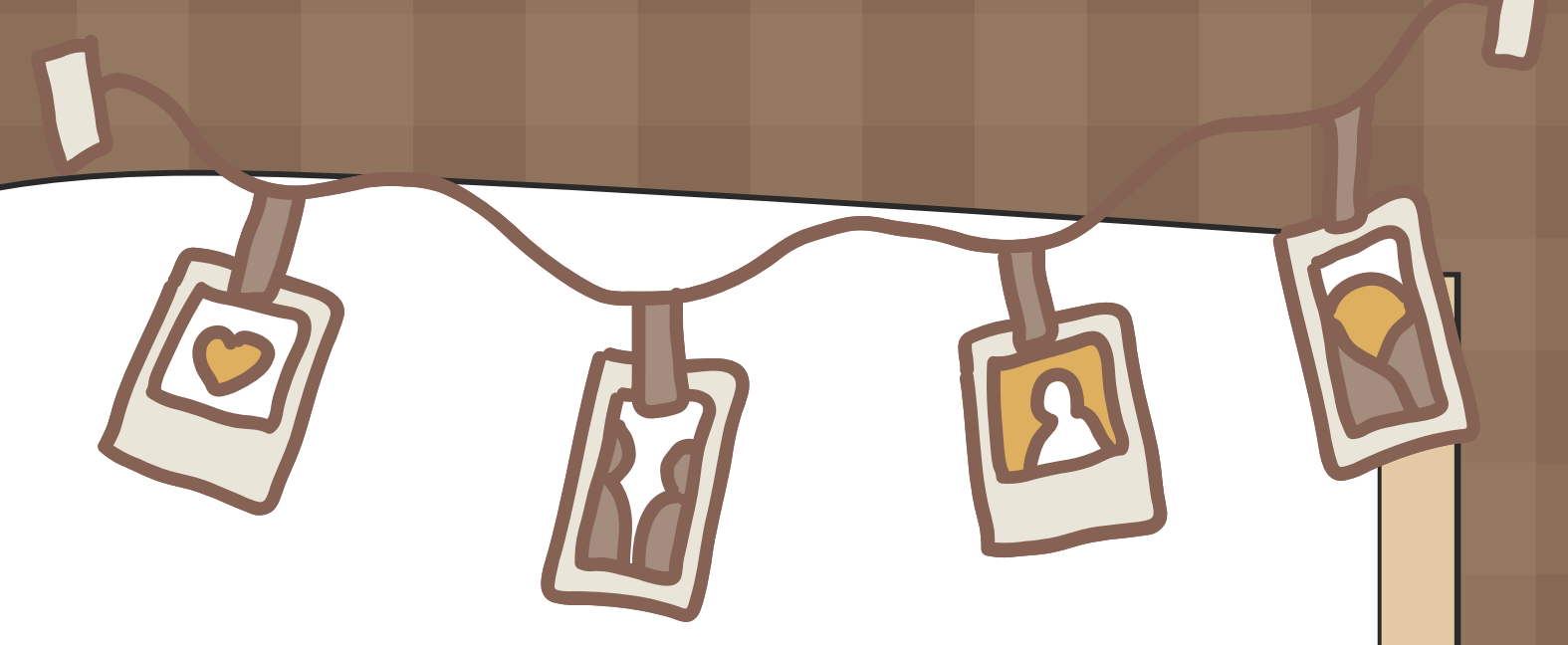
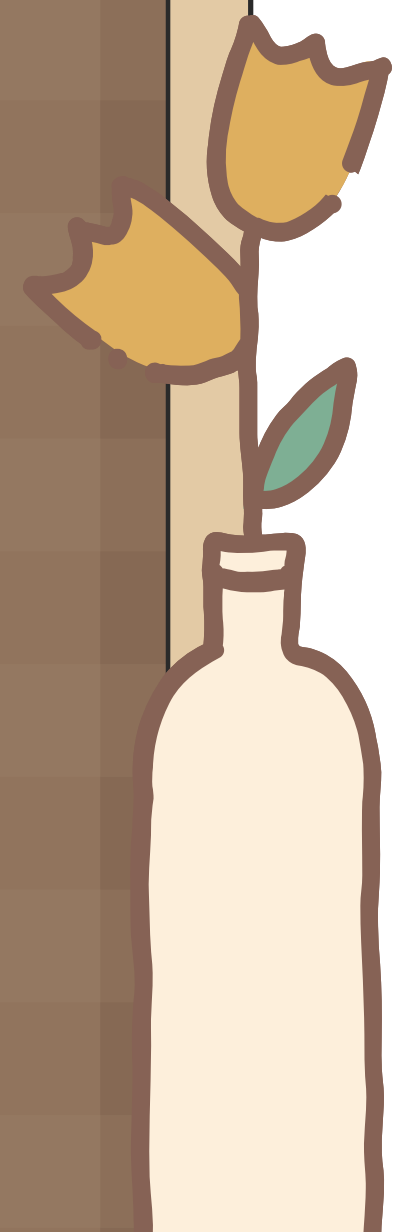

A tapa is a small dish you get for free when you have something to drink.

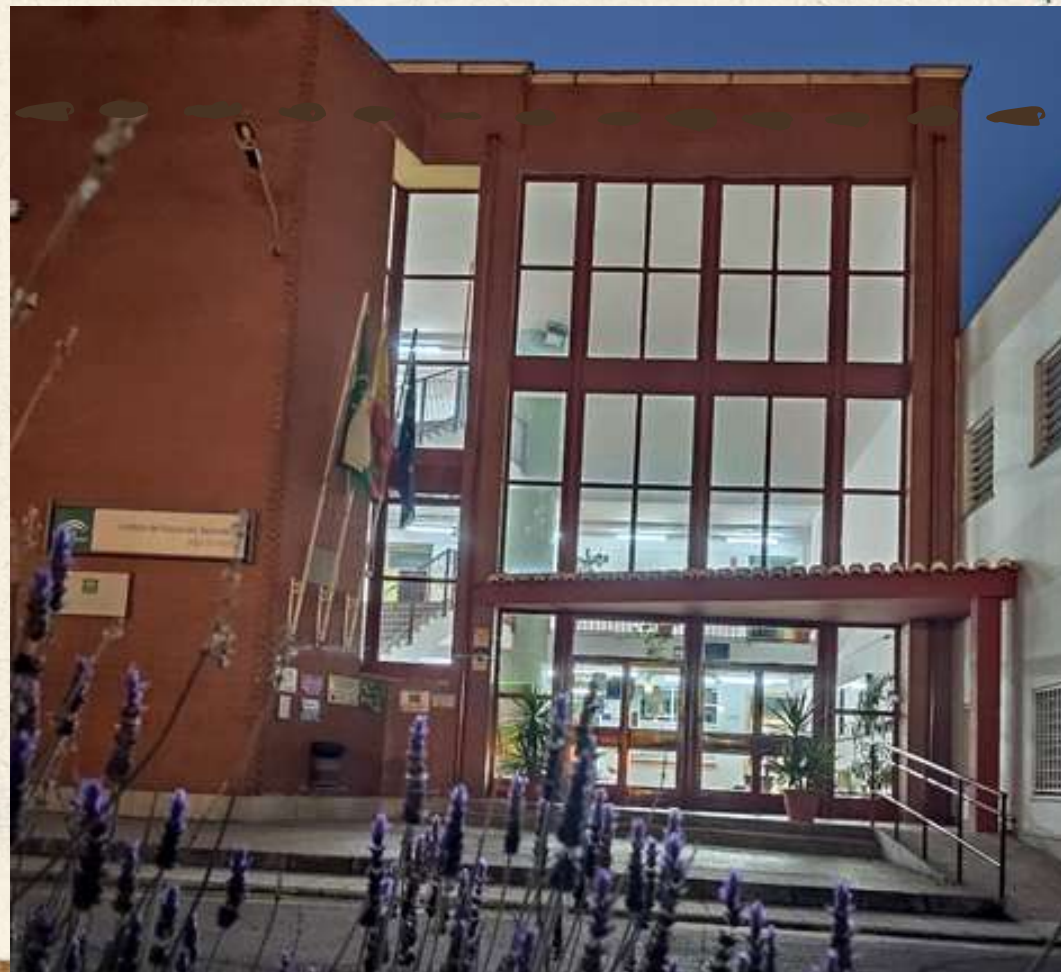

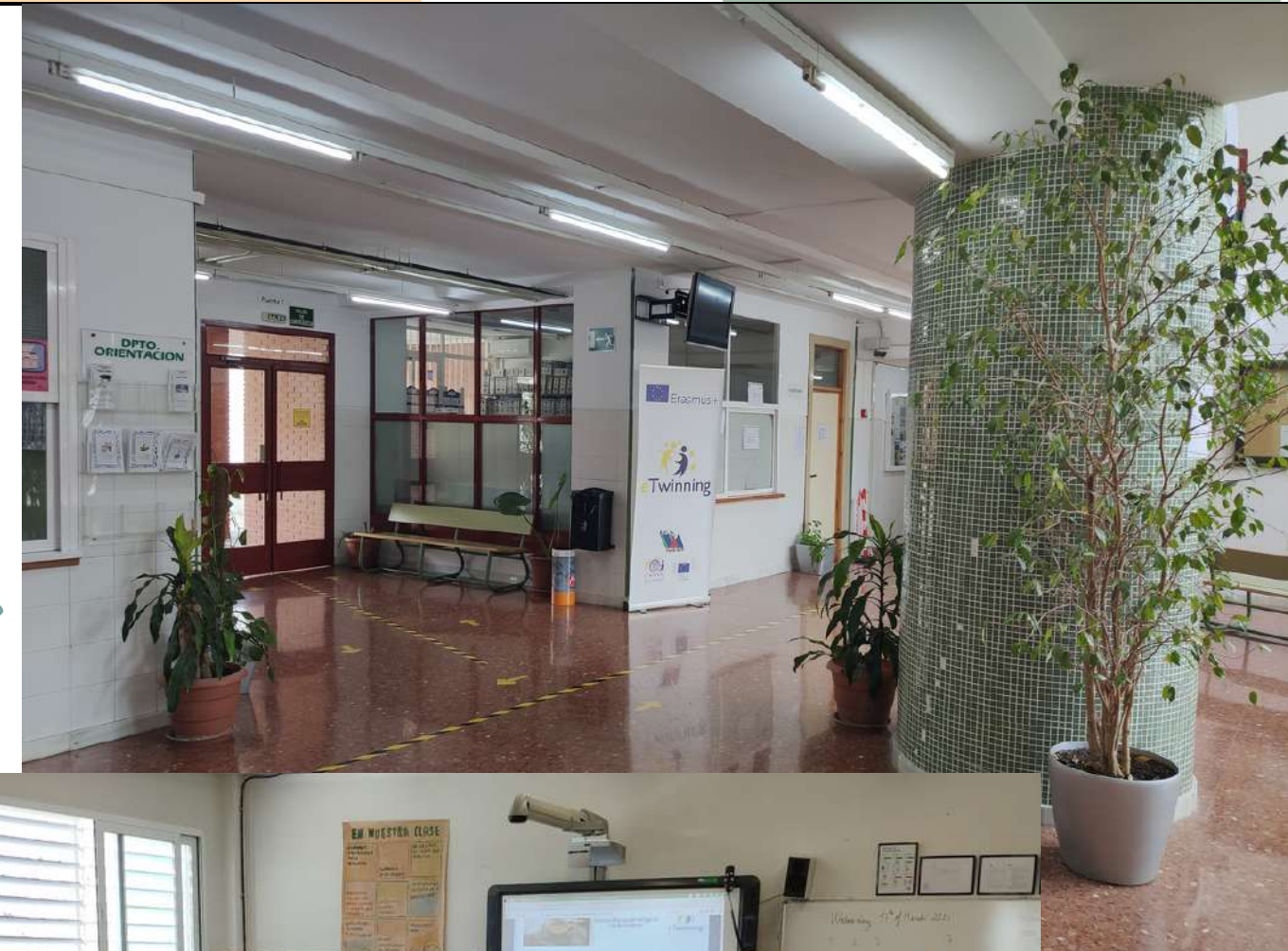

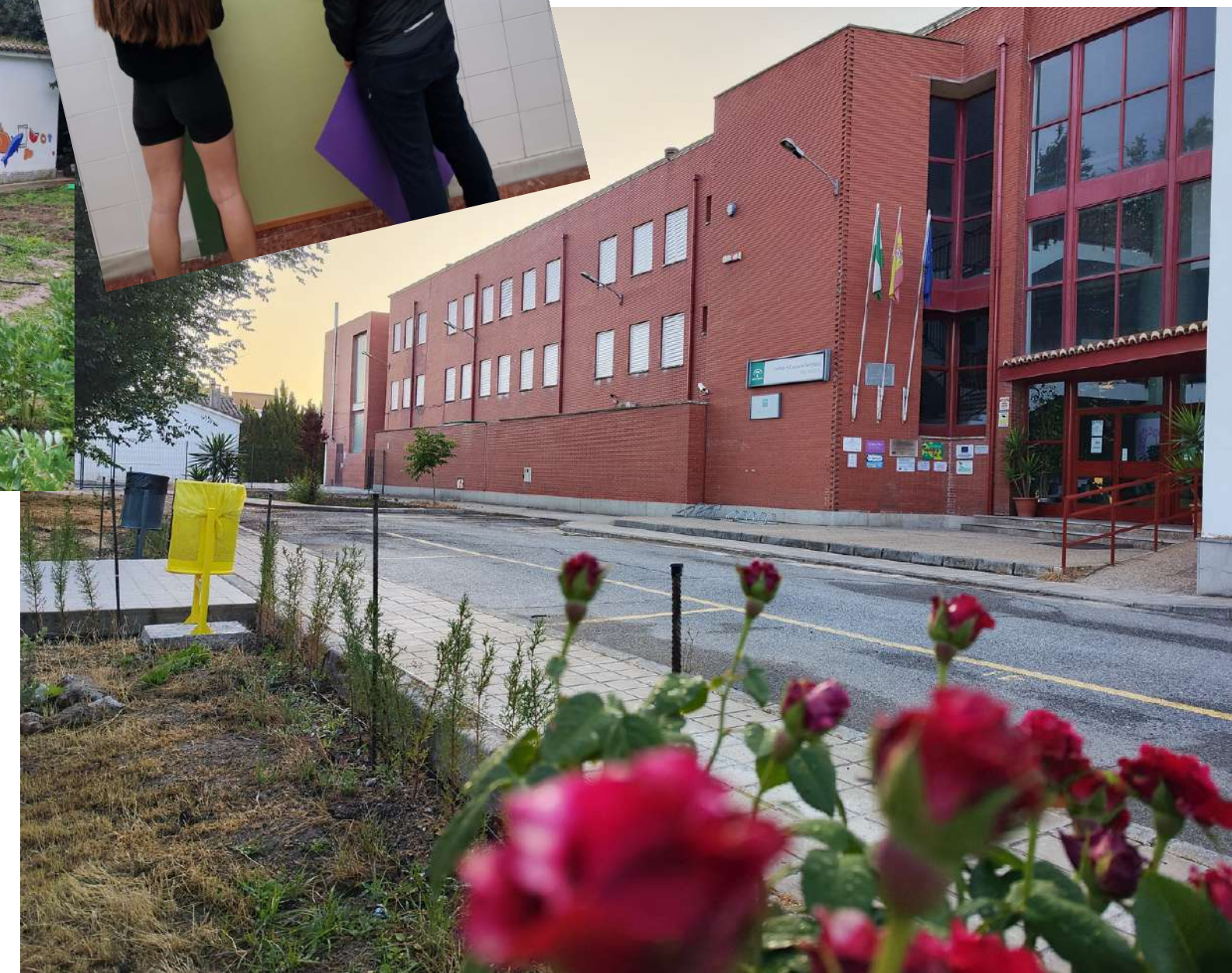
