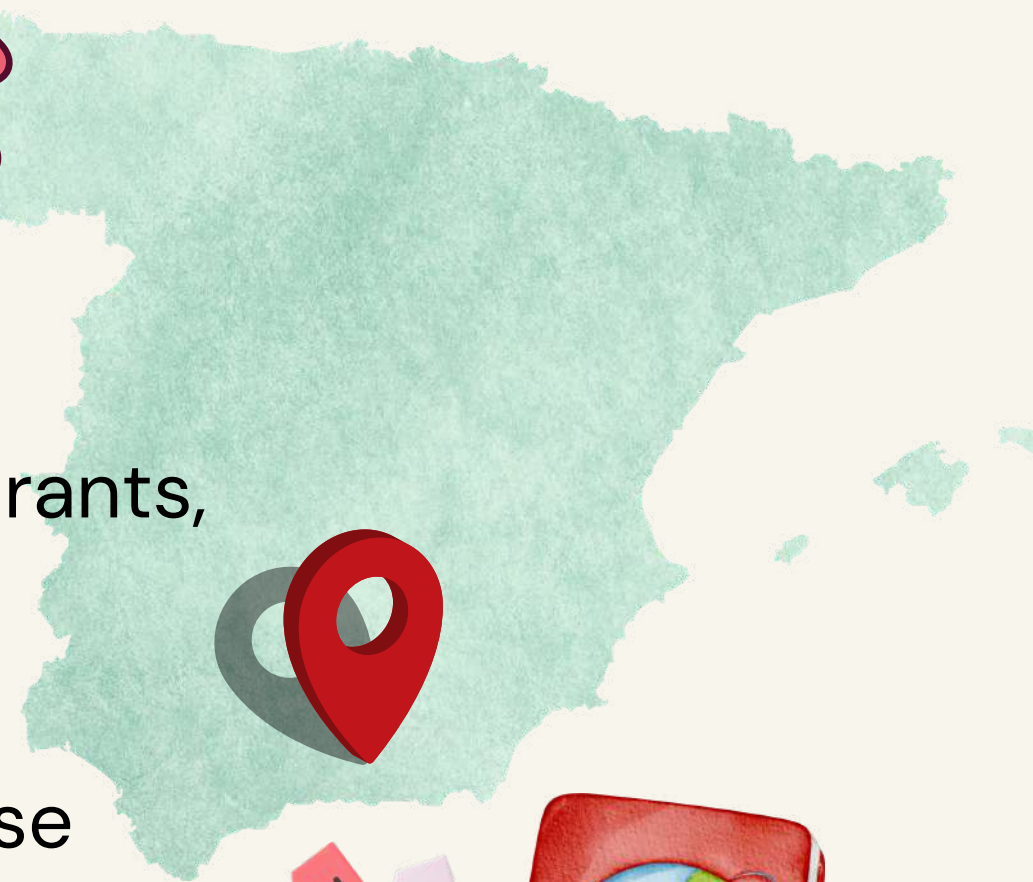


Wi-Fi is widely available in hotels, cafes and restaurants, but it's always good to have a mobile data backup.

Public transport is cheap and frequent. You can use either bus, metro, taxi, Uber

Tap Water is safe to drink in Granada. Lanjaron bottled water is widely available, water from Sierra Nevada

Weather in Granada is cold in winter but it is also warmer during the afternoon. Get ready to dress in layers.

English is not widely spoken. Keep Google Translate handy for any language barriers.

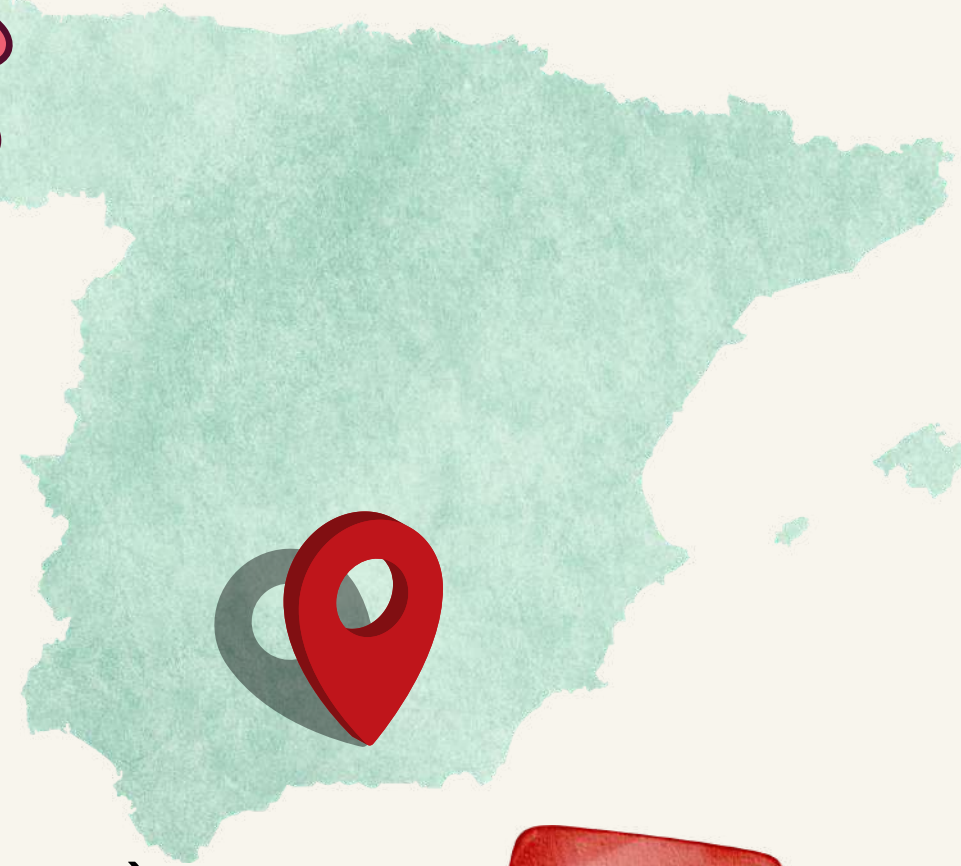

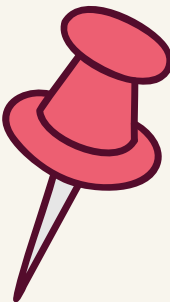

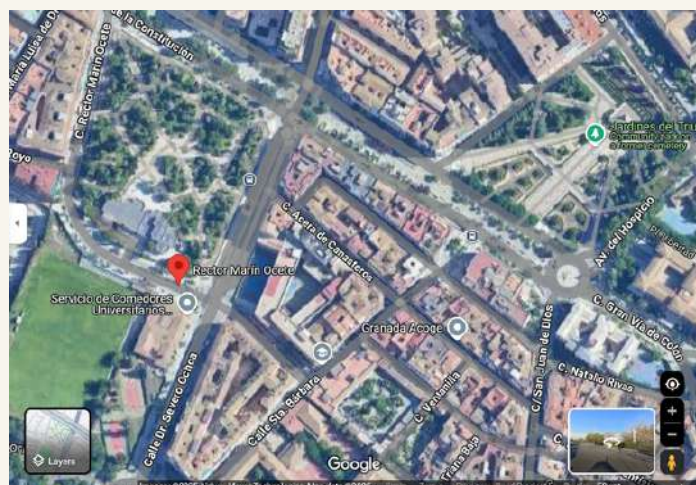
