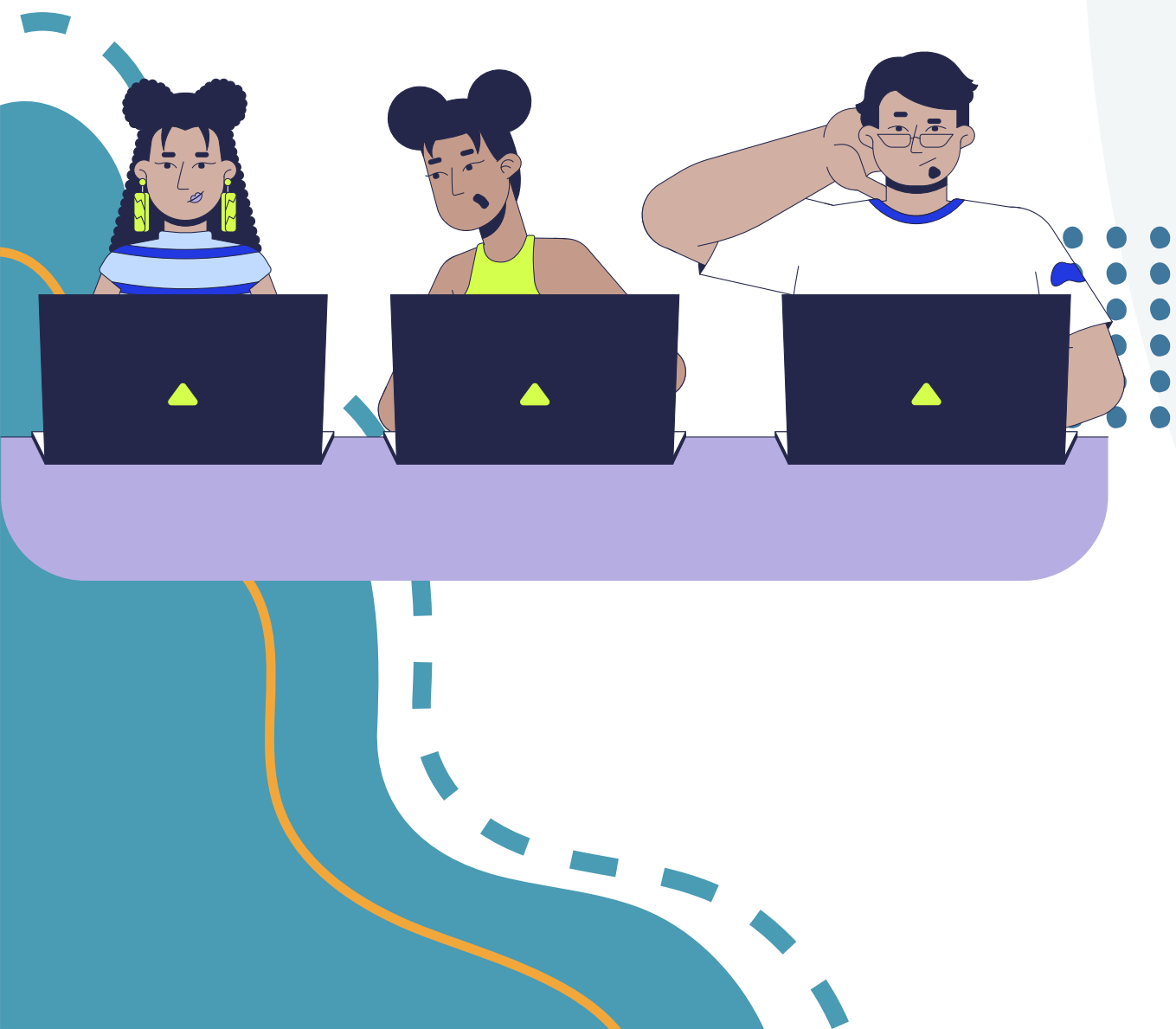

APPRENTICESHIP

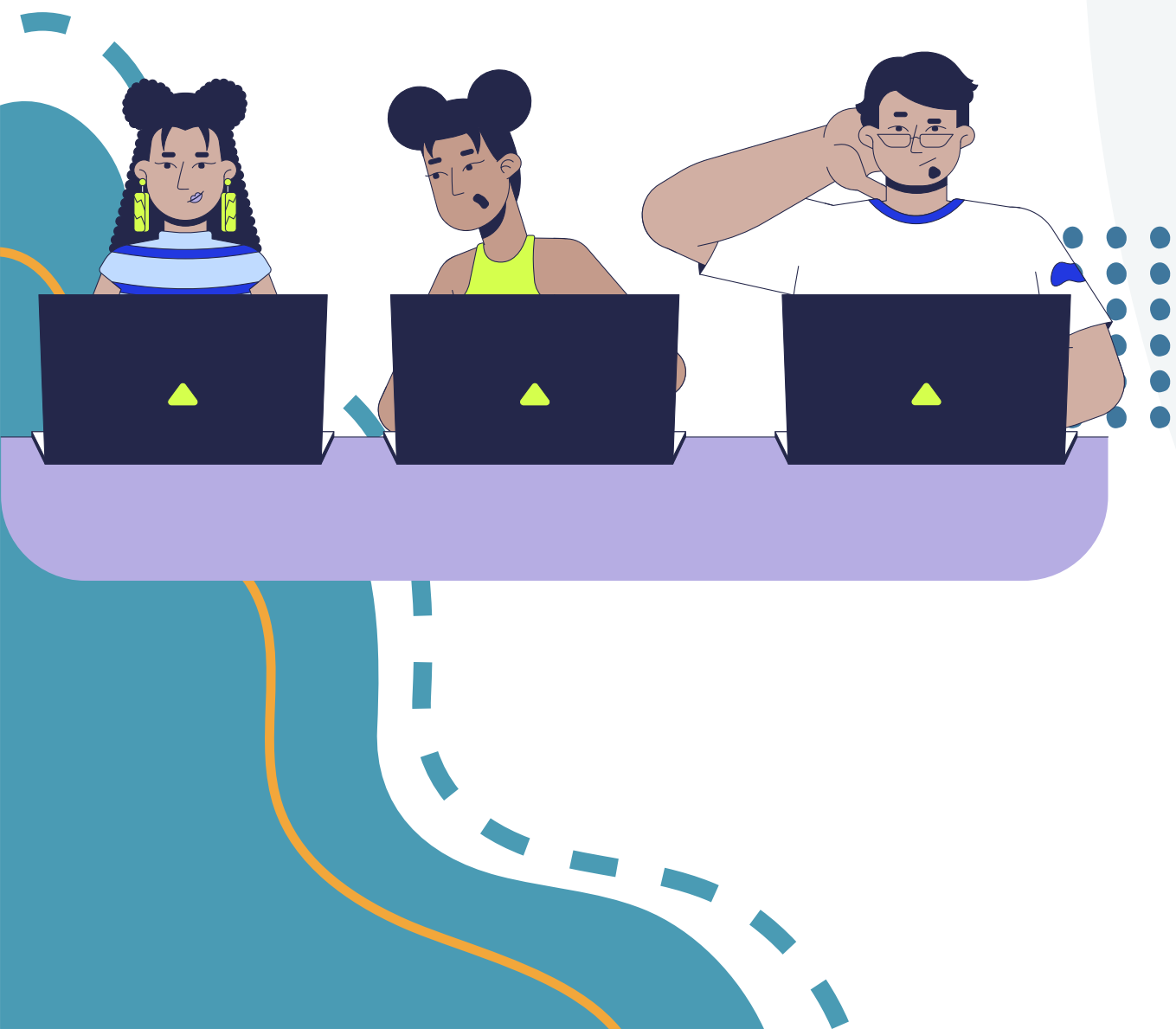
Combining work and study

Continuous assessment

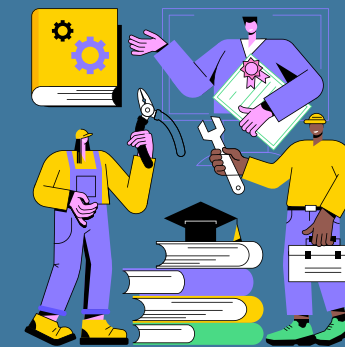
