1. ERASMUS +

Erasmus+ is a program funded by the European Union that aims for personal and professional development by offering grant-supported opportunities to study, intern, or volunteer abroad.

4. SALTO YOUTH

Salto Youth is a platform within the Erasmus+ and European Solidarity Programmes that offers a range of opportunities for youth development and skills acquisition in Europe. It organizes a variety of courses, workshops, and projects to help young people develop leadership, social skills, entrepreneurship, and cultural change.

5. ALMA (Aim, Learn, Master, Achieve)

ALMA targets disadvantaged young people (18–29) not in education, employment, or training (NEET). It offers 2–6 month work-based learning abroad, such as internships or on-the-job training, to build skills, confidence, and employability. Guidance and support are provided before and after the placement.

6. EUROPEAN SOLIDARITY CORPS (ESC)

It's an EU program where young people aged 18-30 can volunteer in Europe. Accommodation, food, travel expenses, and pocket money are covered free of charge.

2. EUROPASS

Europass is a set of standardized documents that help individuals present their qualifications, skills, and experiences clearly across Europe. It includes the Europass CV, Language Passport, Mobility, Diploma Supplement, and Certificate Supplement, aimed at improving mobility and employability within European countries.

3. YOUTHPASS

Youthpass is a certification system by the European Commission for participants in youth programs like Erasmus+ and the European Solidarity Corps (ESC). It recognizes the skills and learning outcomes gained through volunteering or educational activities, allowing young people to document their experiences and competencies.



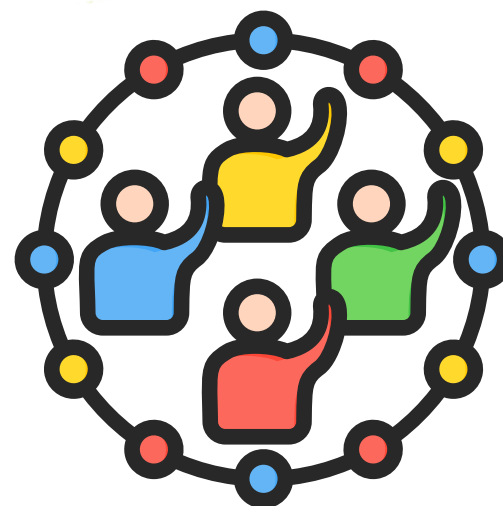

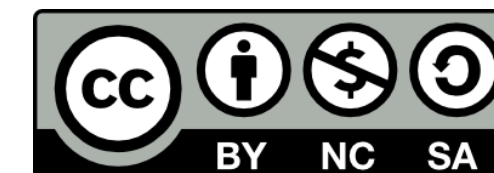

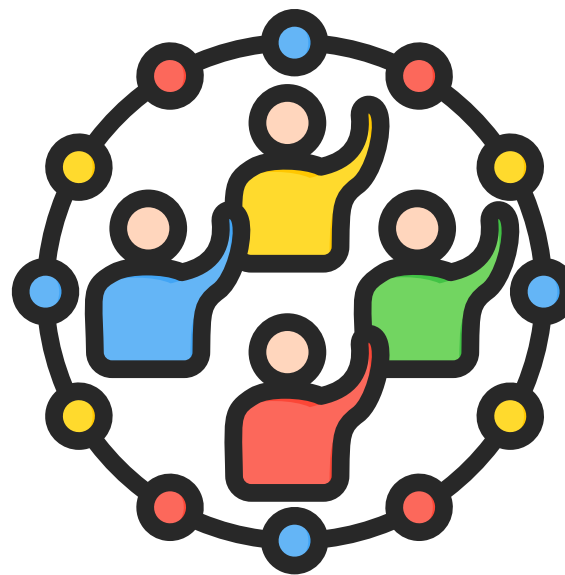
